Joan Mann has been an athletic trainer for 29 years and a high school teacher of sports medicine and physical education classes for 38 years. She earned a BS in Health and Physical Education from Campbellsville College and later earned her MA at Eastern Kentucky University. To continue with her passion, Joan earned her Rank I at ECU with an emphasis in Sports Medicine. Mann is an active member in NATA, SEATA, and KATS, along with the National Retired Teachers Association and Kentucky Baptist Disaster Relief Team.
